**Hever Castle is a romantic double-moated castle, the oldest part of which dates back to 1270. It is famous for being the childhood home of Anne Boleyn and has one of the best collections of Tudor portraits. Other attractions include two magnificent Books of Hours (prayer books), both signed and inscribed by Anne Boleyn. Also contained within the gatehouse is a collection of historic swords and armour.**

**William Waldorf Astor created the Edwardian gardens including the magnificent Italian garden, a 38 acre lake, cascades, grottoes and fountains. Disabled access;- Castle ground floor only. Garden accessible.**
